










EUROPEAN GREEN DEAL

- New strategy of sustainable development and growth of EU
- Presented by EU in December 2019
- Key figures:
 - > The first climate neutral continent by 2050
 - ➤ At least 55% less net GHG emissions by 2030, compared to 1990 levels
 - > 3 billion trees to be planted in the EU by 2030
- Set of regulations, including various closely related areas such as climate, environment, energy, transport, industry, agriculture, sustainable finance





ETS allowances


Producers have to cover CO₂ emissions with ETS allowances

EU importer has to buy CBAM certificates to cover price difference







CBAM TIMELINE

2005

ETS comes into force

The system places annual caps on emissions and creates a carbon market for trading of emissions permits.

January 2026

Permanent system enters into force

Importers declare the emissions embedded in its imports and surrenders the corresponding number of certificates each year. Certificates are priced based on weekly ETS allowances.

October 2023


Trial period

Importers of goods in the scope of the new rules will only have to report GHG embedded in their imports (direct and indirect emissions) without making any financial payments or adjustments.

2026 - 2034

Full implementation

The phasing out of the free allocation under the EU ETS will take place in parallel with the phasing-in of CBAM.












GHG EMISSIONS – SCOPE 1, 2, 3












CBAM SECTORIAL TRAININGS

- To improve the competitiveness, sustainability, and capacity of Serbian exporters in the field of human rights protection and ecology




















RBH – Carbon Management Training
